School Expectations	Respectful	Responsible	Ready to Learn
Playground	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use appropriate and positive language • Be aware of surroundings; such as other students, designated play areas and boundaries • Follow directions of games and share equipment • Understand accidents may happen • Food will only be eaten in the cafeteria • Keep Hands and feet to yourself 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take turns and share • Return equipment to its proper location • Keep track of your personal belongings • Leave natural items in their original place (i.e. mulch, acorns) • Line up directly behind the person in front of you and face the front • Play safely 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When the whistle blows, immediately stop what you are doing and line up • Line up facing forward, in alphabetical order or in your designated spot • Enter the building silently • Follow hallway expectations
Hallways and Traveling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Silence • Hands and feet to yourself • Maintain a reasonable (at least one arm's length) distance between each person 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk single-file with hands crossed or at sides, on the gold line without gaps • Use every step when going up and down stairs • Hold the railings • Have a pass • Stop at stopping points and wait for directions • Pick up litter in hallways and stairwells 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stop at the classroom door and/or stopping points and wait for directions • Enter the room quietly and take your seat
Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow directions of the adults in charge the first time asked • Acknowledge adult requests positively • Be aware of other people's space • Use an indoor voice • Talk only with people at your table • Use polite table manners 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select a balanced meal in the lunch line • Get needed items when in line • Use time wisely • Keep the table and floor clean • Food will stay on the tray • All food will be eaten in the cafeteria • Stay in your seat and raise your hand if you need something 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Line up in alphabetical order, quickly and quietly

Bathroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk quietly • Wait patiently for your turn • Keep your privates private • Give others privacy • Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself • Dispose of garbage properly • Keep the area clean • Respect bathroom walls and doors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flush the toilet • Wash hands • Use resources appropriately • Report misbehaviors, graffiti, and messes immediately • Stay away from windows • Turn the faucet off • Take only enough toilet paper, paper towels, and soap as you need • Use student bathrooms only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return to class promptly
Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enter quietly • Go to your assigned area, and sit down and follow grade level procedures. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If late, go to the office for a tardy slip • Sit on your bottom and leave space for an aisle or sit in your assigned chair • Wait for the signal to go to lockers • Use assigned stairwell • Ask an adult for permission before getting up • Electronics are put in your own locker and are to remain there the entire day (even during lunchtime and recess) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect assignment books and all proper materials to take to class
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk quietly out assigned door with an adult • Walk in a straight line with hands/feet/belongings to yourself • Wait patiently behind the classes in front of you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exit through assigned door • Go to designated area • Be on time • Arrangements to go home are made before 2:00pm. • After school sports/clubs report immediately to assigned area • Stay in line 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have assignment books and all proper materials and homework

Computer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hands and feet to yourself and on your own computer • Use quiet voices • Take care of machines • Login with your name only • Raise your hand if you have a problem 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Print with teacher permission only • Logout before leaving, but leave machines on • Push in your chair when leaving • Use <u>only</u> appropriate materials near the computers • Only work on assigned tasks • Straighten mouse and keyboard before leaving 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sit where directed by teacher • Follow all written and oral directions
Assembly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When class is called, enter and exit silently and move to where directed • Listen when the speaker is addressing the audience • Show appropriate approval • Keep hands and feet to yourself • Remain seated during presentations unless directed to stand or move 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow teacher directions • Know where and how to exit silently from the auditorium • Remain seated 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be attentive and follow the directions of the speaker • When seated, listen quietly for the starting signal
Library	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enter quietly and follow directions • Treat books with care 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Place books back on the collection cart when you are finished • Read silently 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return books in a timely manner
Lockers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open and close lockers quietly • Be aware of your neighbor's personal space • Your locker door is only open to 90° • Only touch your personal belongings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only go at grade level assigned times • Put all electronic devices and personal items in your own locker • Keep your locker clean and organized • Take unnecessary items home • Keep locker combinations private 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect homework, assignments and all necessary supplies for the day • Go to your locker quickly
